



## Policy for Weak and Bright Students

### For Weak students

- After the completion of each sessional exam, obtained result to be used to identify weak students. Student having marks less than 30% of respective subjects are to be considered as a weak student in a particular subject.
- Remedial activities like extra remedial classes and personal attention by subject teachers to be arranged in those subjects in which students have not performed up to the mark. Remedial classes for weak students to be scheduled in the evening.
- If there is no improvement in performance up to second sessional exams which will be identified by second sessional exam result, remedial activities like extra remedial classes and personal attention will continue by subject teachers till Pre-University Test. In addition, new weak students are also to be identified after second sessional exams for remedial classes.
- Remedial Class will only take place in subjects where at least three or more than three students have obtained marks less than 30 percent. If number of weak students is less than three, individual attention will be given by subject teachers.
- The Head of Department is responsible for scheduling remedial /extra classes in the department and Dean (Academics) along with Directors will keep vigilance on the activities.

### For Bright students


- The top academics performers to be encouraged, and awarded on based on their performance after every semester. Students are motivated to secure high marks in university examinations.
- In award ceremonies trophies to be given to institute topper and branch toppers as well as Gold, Silver & Bronze medals to be given to top 3 students of each year and branch.
- Bright students also to be encouraged to appear for various competitive exams like GATE and others. The faculty members are advised to guide and provide study material to students in their free time.
- Students also to be motivated to attend various workshops, seminars and conferences for holistic development.

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**Other reward measures in institute**

- Students securing 100% attendance are also to be awarded with Gold medals and student securing attendance between 98 % and 99.9% are to be given Silver medals and students between 95% and 97.9% are to be given Bronze medals.
