




**Policy for continuous assessment in Laboratory**

- As per university guidelines all practical courses are to be continuously assessed for a maximum of 100 marks (50 marks: Internal assessment & 50 Marks : External assessment) for B Series - Course Code and 50 Marks (25 marks : Internal assessment & 25 Marks : External assessment) for K Series – Course Code
- In every practical session the faculty will evaluate the student on 10 marks scale in their Practical Attendance and Assessment Record on the following parameters and each parameter amounts to 2.5 marks each
  1. Practical work
  2. Practical Completion
  3. File checking
  4. Viva
- Before allotment of the next experiment, faculty member will ensure the checking of practical file by signing with date after conducting viva-voice on respective experiment.
- If any student misses any of the practical due to absenteeism or any other reasons, it is the responsibility of the subject teacher to conduct and assess that student for that practical on the next practical period. It is mandatory that all the students must learn and perform the minimum number of experiments in any Lab as per the university syllabus.
- Final Lab internal assessment marks will be provided to the university on the basis of scaling of average marks obtain by the students of all practical's.
